

WHAT TO PACK

GETTING READY FOR THIS RETREAT!

Bedding

- sleeping bag
- pillow
- extra blankets

Clothing *(Dress is casual and comfortable)*

- jacket and/or sweatshirt
- closed-toed shoes (weather-appropriate)
- hat, or visor
- long pants
- bathing suit (one-piece)
- snow boots, gloves, hat (winter attire)

Toiletries

- personal toiletries (shampoo, shaving things, etc.)
- towel, and shower shoes (flip flops, etc.)

Personal Items

- refillable water bottle
- flashlight and batteries
- spending money (snack bar, gift shop, etc.)
- sunscreen
- Chapstick™
- notebook and pen/pencil
- sunglasses



We *highly* suggest that all personal property (especially luggage) be marked with a name and church/organization before attending the camp. This is helpful in identifying lost items.

Please do not bring anything that would be a distraction to yourself, or others. This would include: any type of music or gaming devices.

!! Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, etc. are strictly forbidden at the camp

!! Be aware of prevailing weather conditions/temperatures in the Idyllwild mountain region. The camp is situated at 5,300 feet – adjust your packing (especially clothing) as necessary.
